Championship Regulations

The Championship will be conducted over 54 holes of stroke play on **May 25-27, 2010** with an optional practice on May 24th. Flights are comprised of approximately 16 players and are determined by scores after 36 holes.

Eligibility

The tournament shall be open to any female amateur golfer, whose primary residence is North or South Carolina based on her federal tax returns, with an established USGA Handicap Index, and who has paid her WCGA annual dues or is a member of a club which has paid its annual WCGA dues prior to the entry deadline. Any applicant whose club has not joined the WCGA may join for her club or as an individual by paying the \$30 annual dues in addition to her entry fee. The field of 96 players shall be comprised of eligible WCGA board members and the players with the lowest handicap indexes whose entry fees have been paid before the closing of entries. Two sets of tees will be used for the 2010 WCGA Championship. All players, **regardless of index**, may opt to play from either the Championship or the Carolinas Tees.

The WCGA Champion and Senior Champion will be determined from contestants playing the championship tees. The WCGA Carolinas Champion and Super Senior Champion will be determined from contestants playing the Carolinas Tees.

The WCGA Championship Winner, Championship Runner-up, and Senior Division winner will automatically qualify for the 2010 Carolinas/Virginias Women's Team Matches. All of these winners will have played the championship tees.

Practice Round

Practice round tee times will be available for players on Monday May 24 starting at 9am. Tee times may be reserved through the Golf Shop at (864) 294-9090 after April 24.

Tournament registration will be at the Furman Golf Club from 10:00am-5:00pm on Monday, May 24. Any late arrivals must notify the Tournament Chairs, Kay Hall (864)420-5289 or Marlene Edwards (864)979-1740 no later than 5:00pm on May 24.

All players must wear appropriate golf attire and soft spikes. Purchases at The Furman Golf Club may be cash or credit card.

Entries

Entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time, either before or during the Championship by the WCGA Championship Committee.

Entry fee for the tournament is a total **\$165** payable in two installments. Fee includes all green fees, cart fees for three tournament rounds, range balls prior to tournament play, dinner, and awards luncheon.

A \$100 check payable to the WCGA and a copy of your current handicap index must accompany each entry form and must be received no later than May 10, 2010. ONE CHECK PER ENTRY. An entry with the wrong "payable to" or incorrect amount will be returned and the entry invalidated. At registration, the balance of \$65 payable to Furman Golf Club will be collected.

Please notify the Tournament Administrator of any withdrawal. The entry fee of \$100 will not be refunded after closing date. Thereafter, no refunds will be given for any cancellations or withdrawals.

Prizes

Prizes and merchandise are awarded to the overall champion. Merchandise is awarded to gross winners in each flight. A tie for overall champion is decided by on-course play-off.

All other ties for trophies and merchandise are broken by score card playoff. Prizes for Super Senior players will be awarded in the Carolinas division.

Divisions: Championship, Senior Championship, Carolinas, Super Senior

Flights within divisions are determined after 36 holes with approximately 16 players per flight.
